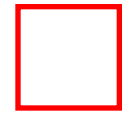

Introduction and instructions for the
Beginners' Course for Algilez

(Pages 4 & 5 explain how to activate the
sound from the loudspeaker icons)

- This is a short course for beginners in Algilez. A classroom-based course, with a teacher and other students is better, but this course is designed for people working individually.
- There are 20 lessons, each taking about 1 ½ hours. When you have completed the course you can then take a test and check your answers.
- The course covers listening, speaking, reading & writing and includes all of the main grammatical features of Algilez and a lot of useful vocabulary.

Advice on learning

- Don't just look at the slides and listen to the recordings. Learning requires action!
- Practise writing what you see on the slides and repeating out loud what you hear on the recordings.
- Algilez words will also be used again in later lessons, so get used to writing down the words and the English translation. Get yourself a notebook and use it to make an alphabetical list.
- Colour coding - questions answers vocabulary





Technical Details - **Important!**

- If you are using a PC, Adobe PDF reader (XI) will display the slides and enable the audio to be played.
- In order to play the sound, click on the '**Enable Editing**', button on the top right of Adobe Reader, then '**OK**'.
- When you click on one of the loudspeaker buttons, you may get a yellow bar security warning. Don't worry! This is simply because the PDF files have been modified by adding audio. Click on '**Options**', '**Trust this document.**' and the audio files will play when you click on them. Save the file using the same filename.

Technical Details - **Important!**

- On mobile devices, Adobe reader does *not* play the audio embedded in PDF files.
- I have found that ezPDF player from Unidocs works, which is available on Google Store. It costs £2-£3.
- Once downloaded and installed on your mobile device, use ezPDF player to open the Algilez lessons.
- To close any unnecessary buttons on the ezPDF screen, click the menu button, middle right side and click Navigation.
